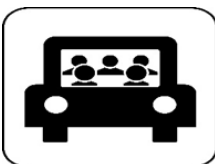

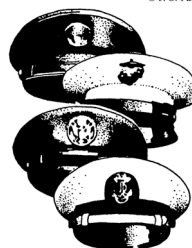

OLM Short Story Book Club

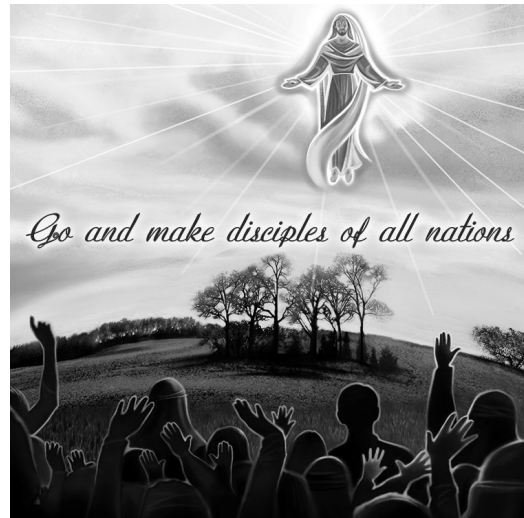
